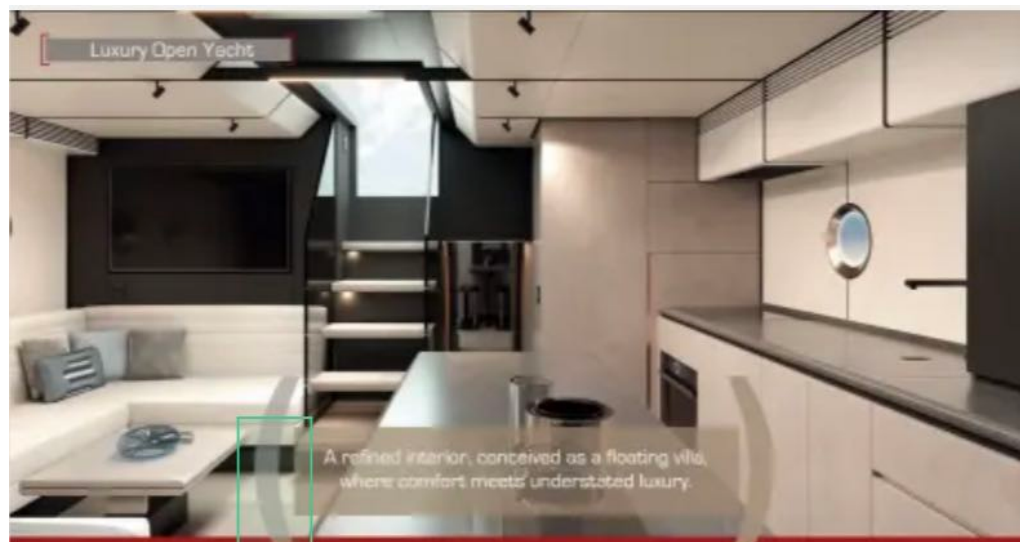
Unveiled at the Cannes Yachting Festival 2025, the all-new VanDutch 75 marks the beginning of a bold new chapter for the legendary brand. Under the direction of Cantieri del Pardo, this model reinterprets the unmistakable VanDutch DNA with a contemporary Mediterranean flair—elevating the brand's timeless identity into a more sophisticated and versatile expression.

HERITAGE REDEFINED

The VanDutch 75 preserves the design codes that made the brand an international benchmark: the low profile, the clean geometry, and the perfect balance of proportions. These have been enhanced with purposeful upgrades such as the carbon fiber hard-top, an integrated anchor system that disappears into the hull, and a cockpit-to-bow access door built directly

into the windshield. The natural teak deck with white caulking, introduced for the first time, underscores the yacht's refined Mediterranean spirit. With a 45-square-meter cockpit, two large opposing sofas, and convertible tables, the outdoor spaces have been reimagined as true living areas, blending conviviality and elegance.

LIFE IN THE OPEN AIR

Designed for both day cruising and long-range adventures, the VanDutch 75 offers a wealth of features usually reserved for larger yachts: a hydraulic swim

platform, a tender garage with launch system, and a fully equipped outdoor galley with barbecue, burners, refrigerator, and ice-maker. With a fuel capacity of 4,000 liters and powered by triple Volvo Penta IPS engines, the yacht combines impressive autonomy with exhilarating performance, reaching speeds of up to 40 knots.

INTERIORS BY BURDISSOCAPPONNI

Inside, Burdissocapponni Yachts&Design introduces a fresh visual language that softens the VanDutch signature

lines with refined textures and bold contrasts. Two moods set the tone: the "Cool" configuration, bright and contemporary with pearl burl veneers, matte black accents and beige suede; and the "Smooth" version, warmer and more enveloping, highlighted by Fulvo mahogany. The standard three-cabin layout reflects this same sense of balance, with a spacious owner's suite, a twin guest cabin and a forward VIP, each with ensuite bathroom. At the heart of onboard living lies a generous open-plan dinette with American-style galley and lounge, while the crew benefits from a fully independent cabin that ensures discreet, seamless service.

A SIGNATURE FOR THE FUTURE

The VanDutch 75 introduces key stylistic elements that will define the future of the range: the signature hull-side window, the lacquered ceiling slats concealing the air-conditioning, and custom marine-grade track lighting. By merging iconic styling with forward-thinking solutions and exhilarating performance, the VanDutch 75 asserts itself not only as the new flagship of the brand but also as the symbol of its future identity. ■ ■ ■
