The launch of the VanDutch 75 marks a thrilling new era for one of the world's most iconic yacht brands. At first glance, the VanDutch 75 is unmistakably VanDutch: that low-slung silhouette, those impossibly clean lines, and the perfectly balanced proportions that have long defined the brand's visual language. But look closer and you'll notice something new. Every contour has been refined, every detail reimaged. The yacht feels sharper, smarter, and even more seductive. Step aboard and the

magic really begins. The cockpit is a dreamscape of open-air indulgence - 45 square meters of pure leisure. Two long, opposing sofas and twin convertible tables form a generous social hub that can easily seat ten guests. The seats themselves are a nod to vintage sports cars, with ribbed upholstery that screams craftsmanship and class. A Fenix galley top integrates a barbecue, burners, fridge, and ice-maker, ensuring you're never far from your next alfresco feast or perfectly chilled cocktail.

Even the hard-top gets a stylish twist. Made from carbon fiber, it offers shade without compromising the yacht's elegant silhouette. And clever design touches abound: an integrated door in the windshield gives effortless access to the bow. At the same time, the "invisible" anchor system rises from the hull like a piece of kinetic art, leaving the deck beautifully uncluttered. Every piece of hardware, down to the smallest hinge, is crafted from high-grade stainless steel - proof that perfection lies in the details. The natural teak decking, now offered with chic white caulking, adds a refreshing contemporary touch that feels distinctly Mediterranean. While officially an open yacht, the VanDutch 75 borrows the best

ideas from larger cruising vessels. Think a hydraulic swim platform that moves up and down for easy water access, a tender garage with its own launch system, and an impressive 4,000-liter fuel tank that lets you roam far and wide without a care in the world. Everything is optimized for long days at sea, from the smart space layout to the abundance of customization options that let owners shape their yacht to their lifestyle.

Designed by BurdissoCapponi Yachts&Design, the interiors bring softness and warmth to the sleek VanDutch aesthetic. Clean lines meet sumptuous materials and rich textures in a way that feels fresh, inviting, and unmistakably luxurious. At its world debut in Cannes, the VanDutch 75 will appear in the "Cool" configuration - a light, breezy mix of pearl burl veneers, matte black woods, beige suede, and moon-hued Econyl flooring that channels modern coastal chic. Those who prefer a cozier atmosphere can opt for the "Smooth" version, where warm mahogany and amber tones create an enveloping, timeless vibe.

The standard layout features three beautifully designed cabins - a generous owner's suite, a twin guest cabin, and a forward VIP cabin with dual-access bathroom - each offering plenty of privacy and understated glamour. The open-plan living area in the middle of the yacht feels both relaxed and refined, with an American-style galley, plush lounge seating, and a convertible dining table perfect for long dinners or late-night conversations. Even the crew quarters are discreetly tucked away, complete with private access and all the essentials to keep life aboard running effortlessly. The 75 introduces new elements that will define the next generation of models: the sleek hull-side window, the lacquered ceiling slats that hide the air conditioning, and custom track lighting developed specifically for marine use. Everywhere you look, materials like brushed copper, dark woods, and matte metal finishes come together in a cohesive, modern palette. Owners can further personalize their yacht with bespoke finishes, ensuring every VanDutch 75 reflects its owner's taste and lifestyle down to the smallest detail. And while all this elegance might make you forget it, this yacht moves like a

dream. Powered by triple Volvo Penta IPS engines, it can reach speeds of up to 40 knots, graceful yet thrilling, fast yet effortlessly stable.
